I received your letter with clippings today and I enjoyed it very much. I'm glad to hear about the gables improving and hope that they will keep it up.

I enjoy the Navy fine, except for the food which is the worst I ever ate. Also they don't give us ~~enough~~ enough of it.

We got our uniforms today and formed our platoon, which is no. 78.

I saw two good football teams play today, as good as I betted than most college games.

The Marines played the Navy and the Navy won in the last few minutes 7 to 6. The game was really spitting and the teams were really supported. There were 5,000 sailors and 5,000 Marines that saw the game and it was really swell to see a good football game. After the

gone there were U.S.O. shows here
which was really good.

This Sunday I will be
able to church because I now
have a uniform.

I listen to the world
series every day because I always
clean up the Command of the
"Boat" camp office during the
game and it usually takes 2 or more
hours for me to do it. The
