I got the box with cameras, pecans, cake etc. and really enjoyed the stuff. I enjoyed the pecans especially.

Well we've been here much longer than I expected and much longer than any of the officers expected so I still don't know whether we're going to leave. ~~Anyway~~

I have been getting Records + Paper regularly. Did you get the letter with pictures in it.

Well a fellow just told me to get ready we're going over to play Ft. Ord's basketball team. That's all for now.
