Dear Folks

10/ oooah! The war's over!

We heard the news yesterday about the President's announcement and the biggest question in our minds now is when will we get discharged.

I haven't been writing much lately because I kept thinking that maybe I was going home. Three weeks ago, on July 25 they received orders here appointing me an Aviation Cadet and orders for me to report to Liberty College in Liberty, Missouri (10 miles from Kansas City) on June 28.

For some reason they had been over a month late and the personnel office here sent a dispatch to find out what to do about it and as yet they haven't heard.

I think they could have sent me on anyway, but they didn't so now I don't know what will happen, since the war's over and I've been so long hearing.

I didn't write you about it because I kept thinking that maybe I would get to come home on leave and I wanted to surprise you. Maybe I'll get home yet but I hope it will be for good.
