I have received several letters from you during the last two days, which have been the first I have received in some time.

I was very amused at the article by Morris Franks and the one about the Rev. Watts.

I'll watch the new point system I stand a chance to get out of the Mess in June 1950. I have a total of 24 points. I am hoping that they will lower it soon and if they don't let me out in time to start school a year from September I'm going over the hill if I can find one.

I went up to see a Navy Captain yesterday about my difficulties with V-5 and he said that I should have been sent home right away but says that there's already sent the dispatch a general if I have to wait and see what they say, if they ever reply.
