Dear folks,

I received a letter from each of you today dated Aug. 11 and 12.

I don't know much of anything to write as nothing much has happened here except that the scuttlebutt (rumors) are flying fast and furious on any and all subjects but there seems to be nothing official except the Navy Joint system which won't affect very many.

I received the clipping you sent about the celebration on Okinawa the night the Japs said they were willing to surrender. We were at a movie pyrehead office announced that the Japs were willing to surrender. Everybody ran around like they were crazy and soon every type of gun was going off. Traps were shooting off into the sky and bullets were flying in all directions. Officers tried to stop it but to no avail. Later they came through the tents inspecting rifles to see if they had been fired. I don't know if they found anyone who hadn't fired his or not. I don't know what they will do about my V-5 now
