Dear Folks,

I have really been getting a lot of mail lately I guess it has been the mail that stacked up after the storm. It has been getting a bunch of "Records" about two months old, but yesterday I got one published on the Sunday after the Wakefield game, I guess they put it off on a fast ship.

We have been reading alot about how fast they are discharging men and sending them home but as far as we can see it's mostly propoganda. I have learned that the men who run the Navy are the biggest liars in the world and that they are going to do everything possible to keep as many men in as long as possible.

I am whole heartedly in favor of merging the Army and

Navy but I can see why Navy officials  
are alarmed. It would mean that the  
Navy would be cut on appropriations.

• But here the Naval enlisted men  
live better than Army officers.

The Navy has about 4 times as much  
money per man as the Army does.

This would also mean that a lot  
of graft would be put to a halt.  
In the Navy, and there is plenty of  
that. The Navy allows up to 10%  
depreciation out of 10% of property  
without a question, but the Army  
takes any loss out of the pay of the  
man who is responsible. This merger  
would make things much easier and  
sure, in operations.

The food over here is really a serious  
problem. They seem to have forgotten  
about the men overseas since the  
war is over.

I guess that's enough on my political  
views for now. I really enjoy reading the  
sports pages that you send me and the  
school paper also. It looks like

year. I really wish that I  
could be playing but am glad  
that they are.

I am glad to see that they have  
a junior team again because that  
is the only way they can expect  
to have a good team in the future.

I have just about made up my  
mind to study law at Texas U.

I then plan to go into politics  
and be Sec of Navy some day and I hope  
that some of these offices I know are  
still in. I don't know if I'll ever  
be able to play ball but I might  
try a year or so anyway.
