WE HAVE JUST HEARD THAT ADMIRAL NIMITZ. HAS ASKED THE WAR DEPT, TO TAKE OVER MIL GOVT, ON OKINAWA AND THAT THE PLAN WILL PROBABLY GO THROUGH BY MARCH 1. THIS MEANS IF IT GOES THROUGH THAT WE MAY HAVE A CHANCE OF GOING HOME OR AT LEAST MOVING TO A DIFFERENT PLACE OR, DEPLAY AT LEAST GETTING SOME SEA DUTY, WHICH WOULD SUIT ME FINE, EVEN THOUGH I AM VERY EASILY MADE SEA SICK. SO, IF WE ARE LUCKE WE WILL BE SENT HOME AS UNIT. THERE IS NOTHING THAT WE CAN DO BUT WAIT AND PRAY.

I HOPE, OF COURSE, THAT WE WILL BE SENT HOME BUT IF WE ARENT I HOPE
THAT I WILL BE SENT TO CHINA OR JAPAN. NO MATTER HOW IT TURNS OUT I
DONT SEE HOW IT COULD BE WORSE THAN THIS. IF I GOT ON A SHIP I
WOULD AT LEAST GET TO SEE SOME MORE COUNTRY AND THERE MIGHT BE AXXXXX
CHANCE THAT THE SHIP WO ULD GO TO THE STATES.

THE MAIL HAS JUST COME IN AND I HAVENT HEARD FROM YOU IN 4 DAYS.

I HAEVNT HAD A REPLY TO THE LETTER THAT I WROTE YOU AFTER RETURNING
FROM JAPAN BUT I SUROSE THAT I WILL GET IT SOON.

I GOT THE ANNIVERSARY EDITION OF THE RECORD "AND I ENJOYED IT VERY MUCH . I HAVE BEEN GETTING ALL THE RECORDS IN ABOUT 2 MONTHS.
