DEAR FOLKS,

IT'S SUNDAY AGAIN AND I AM BACK AT THE OLD TASK OF LETTER WRITING . THERE IS NOT MUCH NEWS FROM THIS SIDE OF THE WORLD.

FOR THE LAST TWO DAYS I HAVE BEEN WORKING ON A VOICE RADIO CIRCUIT SINCE THE TELETYPE HAS BEEN OUT OF ORDER BUT ITS BEEN FIXED AND AM NOW BACK ON THE OLD JOB. THE VOICE RADIO WAS PRE ETY INTERESTING WORK BUT IT INVOLVES A LITTLE MORE WORK THAN DOES THE TELETYPE . WE WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE THE VOICE HOOK UP ONLY FOR ABOUT 15 MINUTES A DAY IN THE MORNIGN NOW THAT THE THE TELETYPE IS BACK IN ORDER .

I HARDLY KNOW ANYONE AT THIS PLACE ANYMORE MOST OF THE FELLOWS THAT I CAME OVERSEAS WITH HAVE GONE HOME . MOST OF THEM ARE ALL YOUNG KIDS AND JUST CAME OVERSEAS WHICH MAKES ME AND OLD SALT AS THE SAYING GOES . I WILL BE ABLE TO GET SECOND CLASS AS SOON AS MY TIME IS UP. YOU HAVE TO BE THIRD CLASS FOR 6 MONTHS BEFORE YOU GO UP TO SECOND . XMOXXX THE FELLOWS WHO OPERATED THIS MACHINE BEFORE I DID WERE ALL 1ST AND SECOND CLASS SO THERE IS PLENTY OF COMPLIMENT .

I LIKE THE JOB MUCH BETTER THAN THE OLD ONE AND HAVE MORE RESPONSIBILITY. IT relieves a little of the ~~monotony~~ ~~monotony~~ and it makes the time pass all the much faster . I am ready at any time to go home however.

I guess that you noticed the new typewriter , the old one is just about shot it went through the rugged okinawa campaign.

I dont have much to say as there arent any late developments here. Now is the time for all good men to come to the aid of their country.

Thats all for now I hope that you will excuse this short letter .
