I still havent gotten used to this typewriter.

The laundry here has been out of order for some time , so I had to wash my own clothes for the first time in a long time , yesterday afternoon.

Only 48 more days before I go to NOB to await trans. home .I sure hope that I wont have to wait long down a t that place for a ship as I want to get home as soon as possible and the quaters they have for men in transient arn't very good . The chow lines are tremendous, I hear.

I hope that the clothing situation will be somewhat releived by the time I get home . I guess that you are buyinng all that you can for me now . I may be ablet o get some white shirts before getting out of the navy.If you think that we can use some sheets forr single beds let me know because I can get several of t hem free.
