Dear Folks,

I received some more letters from you
Saturday, but haven't gotten any so
yet today.

The draft that is leaving this month before
the one that I am on leaves early so that
they will catch a ship. The one that left
last month also left early so maybe I will
will be able to do likewise.

I had a letter from a friend of mine who lives
in Chicago and who changed his address to
Los Angeles. He was discharged on the West
Coast and received 5 cents a mile to his
place of enlistment.

Has received 114 dollars and flew home.
The flight home cost him 144 dollars
so he came out just about even.

That is what I am going to do. I am
going home with two boys whom I
have seen with and Boot Camp.
One Wally Pettigrew lives in Los Angeles
and the other Charles Gillis lives in
Boaters. Gillis and I are changing
our address to the address of Wally. We
will be discharged there and try to buy a
few dollars and then fly home. We
won't have to ride on one of their old
troop trains and will get out of the Navy
sooner.

I hate about all that news. I'll call you
when I arrive on the West Coast. You
don't need to worry about flying home so
I can send it's just as safe as train
