Dear Folks:

I havent written in a little spell so I guess that I had better get off this little communique to you.

Not much news from here but a lot of scuttlebutt is flying thick and fast. NOB is filled to capacity and they dont know when any ships will come in. If a ship or ships come in and clear out the place I think that we will be sent down ahead of time, but at the present there is no room for anyone else there. They have about three thousand personnel waiting for ships down there now and one ship that isnt loaded would clear out enough so that we would be able to go down early.

Time is really drawing near for me to become a civilian and I am hoping for the best. --- I havent heard from you as much as I was for awhile. I got only one letter ~~from~~ from you last week and it was pretty old, I havent gotten a letter at all this week, of course on ly one day has passed this week.

I will really be glad to get off this island and be able to get some good chow. The food situation here is really bad; we are eating the same food that we had during the invasion. Once in awhile we have good food but not very of ten.

Nothing much to write about here.

Continued. 15 May. I forgot all about this letter until I found it. I had to quit writing and I put the letter aside and forgot it.

There isnt anything new to write about here. NOB is still full and no ships have come in. We are ready to go as soon as they empty it.

I received 5 letters yesterday and today. I hope it wont be necessary to write long much longer.
